Description:

Guidelines and Rules

- 1- Qualifications:** Any student who has the will to participate can, provided he/she has the skills needed for the specific Project/Competition, for example: public speaking, mastering a language, passion for research, excellence in using software, talent in filming/drawing/dancing, good in sports etc...
- 2- Innovation:** Only innovative, out of the box ideas will be accepted. Students should have the ability to be critical thinkers and to come out with ideas never thought of before.
- 3- Liability:** A student who decides to be part of any project/competition:
 - Should be responsible and an active participant whether working individually or with a group.
 - Should meet all deadlines without being reminded continuously to submit assignments.
 - Should follow proper instructions given to them.
 - Should not plagiarize or copy any idea from anyone.
 - Should not ask to be exempted from a class or from any exam, or even ask for an exam to be postponed.
 - Should not be absent from any class to work on the project unless submission of a project is during school hours, and this requires the Rector's approval.
 - Should be able to defend the project/competition in proper English/French/Arabic language.

PS: Students should be aware that participating in projects/competitions will enrich their portfolios to universities, especially Ivy League.
