



Undergraduate Admission: Early Admission (Freshman & Sophomore)

Early Admission to AUB is based on the following :

1. Rank in top 25% in G10 and top 25% in G11
2. Required SAT I Minimum Scores

Applying to (Fall 2022-23 or later)	Minimum total SAT I Evidence-Based Reading and Writing + Math
Freshman year	1130
Sophomore Arts (except Economics) and Nursing	1170
Sophomore Sciences (except Biology) and Economics	1270
First year Graphic Design	1270
First year all faculties (Agricultural and Food Sciences, Health Sciences and Business) except Engineering and Architecture	1270
Sophomore Biology, first year Engineering and Architecture	1300

Note: For early admission, the above requirements must be present all at once.
If any is missing or not fulfilled, the application is switched to regular admission automatically

AUB English Language Requirements

AUB requires all applicants, regardless of citizenship, to demonstrate English language proficiency or Readiness for University Study in English (RUSE).

Undergraduate applicants can demonstrate RUSE by submitting satisfactory and valid scores from one of several tests (as shown in the above table).

Demonstrating RUSE for undergraduate applicants		
Test	Minimum Score	Validity
SAT (evidence-reading and writing)	530	2 years
TOEFL iBT	79	2 years
IELTS (Academic)	6.5 with no single component <6	2 years
AUB-EN	40	1 year

Undergraduate Admission: Regular Admission (Freshman & Sophomore)

Admission to AUB is based on the following:

- Calculations of
 - 50% of high school final year averages for G10 and G11 and
 - 50% of SAT 1 score based on the below SAT1 Sections:
Evidence-based Reading and Writing + Math
- The student final year average is compared to his/her class average
- SAT 1 can be done several times. We will do super-scoring (i.e. taking the maximum of each section from all sessions).
- Check SAT registration deadlines the soonest to plan accordingly.



Financial Aid: Rules and Regulations

- Awards are made based on need and range from **35% to 70%** of tuition.
- If awarded, the financial aid grant is valid for the normal period of study, as long as you remain in good academic standing.
- Financial need is not a factor in the admission decision.
- Separate application for financial aid should be submitted within 30 days from the admissions application submission.



Tuition Assistance: Scholarships and Work Study

- **Merit Scholarship**

Each year AUB awards **full-tuition** merit scholarships to 10 new undergraduates with outstanding academic qualifications.

- **Early Admission Merit Scholarship**

A **30%** scholarship is awarded to sophomores who apply early and are admitted.

- **Lebanese Baccalaureate Scholarships**

Full-tuition scholarships to the top 5 of the four Lebanese Baccalaureate tracks.

- **Work Study**

Students can apply for work study to the office of the Dean of Student Affairs, and receive **10%** financial aid.
